Governance arrangements	The Governing Body of St. Andrew's Primary School was re-constituted in May 2017 and is currently made up of 11 governors:
	<ul> <li>5 Co-opted Governors (1 Vacancy)</li> <li>3 Parent Governors</li> <li>2 Staff Governors (including the Head)</li> <li>1 Local Authority Governor</li> <li>We also have 1 Associate Governor.</li> </ul>
	The full Governing Body meets once each term. We also have a number of committees to consider different aspects of the school in detail. These include Curriculum and Standards, Finance and Premises, First/Pay Review and Headteacher Performance. We also have committees that meet as required to consider pupil discipline, staffing matters and any appeals.
Attendance record of governors	Governors have excellent attendance records at meetings, as can be seen from the records held on the school website. We have only had to cancel a meeting once because it was not "quorate" (the numbers needed to ensure that legal decisions can be made) since June 2013.
The work that we have done on our committees and in the governing body	We have been involved in a number of significant decisions in this past year, focused on school improvement. These include:
	Confirming our Acting Headteacher as the permanent post holder and appointing a new Deputy Head into post. Being involved in all aspects of the above recruitment processes.
	We have strengthened our Governing Body with the addition of 2 new Governors who bring a wide range of excellent and varied skillsets to bolster and improve the team.
