Teachers will be using Class Dojo to reward children in and out of the classroom. The system is most effective when parents join in and monitor their children on the Class Dojo App or website.

To help parents access this facility we have added a link to our website to make it easier for you to register your personal code, which you will find attached to the Behaviour Policy for Parents.

There is now a messaging service with Class Dojo for teachers to send individual messages about the children's behaviour and so it is important that ALL parents log on and enter their password.
