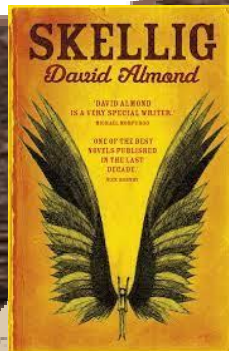

Science

How does light travel?

- * recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines
- * use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye
- * explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes
- * use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.

How are living things grouped?

- * describe how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including micro-organisms, plants and animals
- * give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics
